The following units have been retired and replaced by new units.

POL237 Terrorism and Political Violence in South Asia is replaced by POL337 Terrorism and Political Violence in South Asia
 POL335 Policing, Intelligence and Counterterrorism is replaced by POL202 Politics of Policing Counterterrorism

Retired subjects, BAR150 and PHL131 used to be core and major units in the old course structure and will still be counted towards the degree as electives.

Pre-2020 Bachelor of Arts in Security, Terrorism and Counterterrorism Studies units BAR100, BAR200 and BAR300 can be used in place of MSP100, MSP200 and ART208 respectively.
