Additional Course Info

We strongly recommend that you enrol in the order of units as shown in the study plan. This will give you the best learning experience and allow you to complete in the shortest time.

In the study plan you will see that there are four units recommended for your first semester of study (year 1, top line), four for your second semester (year 1, second line) and so on. This is the recommended pathway for a full-time study load. If you are studying part-time, begin with the first units listed and work your way across, from left to right, then from semester to semester.

For example:

- if you intend to study part-time and enrol in 1 unit, we recommend that you begin with EDU106, as this unit will prepare you for your overall study experience
- if you intend to study part-time and enrol in 2 units, we recommend that you enrol in EDU106 and EES161
- if you intend to study part-time and enrol in 3 units, we recommend that you enrol in EDU106, EES161 along with either EES162 or EDU102
