

Access and equity travel subsidy application form

OUA offers a travel subsidy to assist undergraduate students on low incomes who are required to travel as part of their study. Students who meet the criteria below may be eligible to receive a travel subsidy of \$100.

Undergraduate students living 100 kilometres or more from where their attendance is required for an exam or practicum requirement, may receive a travel subsidy of \$100.

Access and equity application requirements

- Australian citizens and Australian Humanitarian Visa holders, residing and travelling in Australia are eligible to apply for access and equity travel subsidies.
- Students must be currently enrolled in the subject(s) requiring travel when applying for a subsidy.
- If applying for an exam subsidy, include a copy of your OUA Exam Services timetable.
- Funds will be forwarded to the student after the census date in the study term of travel.
- A subsidy cannot be awarded for subjects completed in past study terms.
- Students must provide documentation verifying that they are in receipt of Centrelink Benefits OR that they hold an Australian Health Care Card.

Please note: students may also apply in cases where:

- There are factors other than distance that make access to the required location difficult, for example physical disability.
- Low income cannot be demonstrated by the above means but other evidence can be submitted.
